The exposure to asbestos concentration should be limited to less than 0.1FPC/8 hours work schedule. Surface wetting with pressure sprayer (water + wetting agent) prepares the work area. Using HEPA vacuum cleaners can eliminate as much dust as possible.?

Asbestos removal is generally considered quite safe, as long as the contractor and workers involved follow the standard safety procedures and work within the limitations set out by the guidelines they are given.
