Every tenant should at least know where to shut off the water supply so as to temporarily stop the loss of water and water pooling in a particular area in the home. And slow leaks can also be problematic so they will also need to be fixed temporarily. And home occupants should also ensure that they have a toilet plunger for those times when the toilet gets clogged.

Electrical problems are also quite common and it would also be advisable for tenants to have some knowledge about the electrical system, such as the location of the circuit breaker. However, it is also important to contact the landlord or property manager if the tenant was able to reset it and turn it back on because the tripping of the circuit breaker might be a symptom of a worse problem. Electrical problems can lead to fires so it would be best to have the electrical system checked by a professional electrician.

While it is the responsibility of the landlord or the property manager to perform the necessary repairs, it is important for tenants to be knowledgeable on what they can do for the mean time that the maintenance crew are still on the way.
