Part of the answer, according to the clinic, is to put a victim of addiction in inpatient rehab (also known as residential treatment). By doing so, the clinic’s staff and care providers have the unique ability to learn about their patient’s needs over an extended period of time. It is vital, says Rehab Near Me, to observe a patient’s addiction in the safe, stable environment of the clinic’s premises in order to ascertain how their treatment should be carried out. “We believe that it is both inadvisable and ineffective to attempt to help a patient without knowing as much about their condition as we can. We have found that an inpatient program is the most reliable method of gaining this information while also keeping the patient as safe as possible, within reach of healthcare and emergency personnel.”

RNM states, “The problem with addiction is that it keeps people from quitting the substance of their choice. That is why addicted people struggle with cravings and other temptations. Addictive substances alter their brain in a way that dulls their judgment and keeps them from making good decisions.” Addictive substances tend to change the brain chemistry of their victims, making the substance itself seem “rewarding” to the sufferer. While a reward system is normally essential for survival, such as the response of feeling pleasure when food is consumed, addictive substances can take precedence even over the need to survive. This usually extends to a great many other pleasures and necessities as well, such as the company of friends and family, a stable work environment, and more.

“Even if they manage to stop for a while,” continues Rehab Near Me, “they will go through withdrawal and eventually relapse. It becomes dangerous to quit without the aid of medical professionals.” The clinic further notes that both sufferers of addiction and those who care about them should be aware that withdrawal symptoms can range from mild to life-threatening. “Without proper treatment, a person suffering from addiction is at risk of getting progressively worse,” warns the clinic. “It is better to get help early, when the symptoms of withdrawal are much easier to handle, than it is to wait and simply hope that the addictive habits will go away on their own. Furthermore, it is absolutely vital that people with more disruptive withdrawal symptoms are taken care of by experienced professionals.”
