Sometimes they will do such things as build up a little excess moisture and this can cause corrosion of parts. He says they have even seen cases where mice and other rodents have eaten through wires while making nests inside an HVAC system. The buildup of dust and other grime during a long non-use period can also contribute to problems when an HVAC unit is called upon to supply heat again.

The owner also went on to talk about what there fall HVAC inspections cover by saying, "Our HVAC Denver service techs are very well trained and experienced at what they do. Before they start any HVAC inspection, they will clean up any dust and grime that has built up on an HVAC unit. Once this is done, they know exactly what to look for as far as potential problems go with an HVAC system. These are such things as burnt wires, severely corroded parts and other red flags that an HVAC heating system may not function right when it's started up. Of course, our techs will thoroughly run and test the system to make sure it's working properly too."
