Kucharz went on to add that winter weather is his absolute biggest concern as far as roof damage goes.

Strong winds and freezing temperatures can really wreak havoc on a roof that's not prepared for these things. Ice dams, ice buildup, and heavy snow loads can catch the edges of loose shingle and tear up whole sections of the roof. It's also the time of year where condensation can hurt the integrity of a roof that is in poor shape. That's because the condensation that occurs when warm inside air meets cold outside air builds up under loose and worn shingles and then freezes and expands causing damage.

Fall is not as harsh on roofs as winter weather but it also creates its own set of problems. Many of these come from the strong winds that often occur in Naperville at this time of year. Loose gutters, shingles with frayed up edges, and loose chimney and vent flashing are extremely susceptible to damage from strong winds.

He also mentioned that fall weather conditions are perfect for doing roofing work. Underlayments, shingles, and other roofing materials go down much better when the temperature is below 60 degrees. This type of weather is even much easier on the roofing crews as they can work harder and longer when it's not so hot outside. Early fall shingle application also gives newly laid down shingle time to bond with a roof's surface and make a good seal before more extreme weather hits. Kurcharz stated that a properly working roof not only keeps the elements out but it also helps insulate a home better during the colder months.

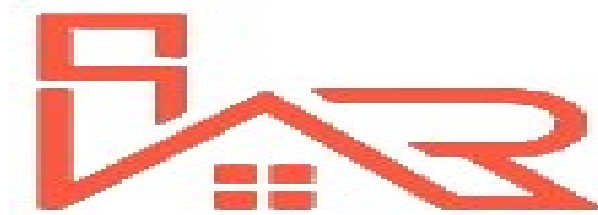
