The soot and smoke residue from fire damage should also be remediated as early as possible. This is because smoke soot is highly acidic and within a number of days, the acid can cause permanent damage to the surfaces in the home. During the initial cleaning, neutralization of this strong acid will need to be conducted right away.

The actual procedures for fire damage remediation will vary widely based on the amount of structural damage, the types of materials that were burned in the fire, and the heat of the fire. The ash, chemicals, and soot that are produced from the fire will vary and will need different cleaning procedures.

The company also provides remediation services for various kinds of water damage. These include flooded basement cleanup, ice damming, pipe leak cleanup, and wet carpet cleanup.

Flooding in the basement is usually caused by pipe leaks, toilet overflow, or a water heater with a damaged pressure release valve. The service crew from The Flood Co. will first use a sump pump to extract all of the standing water in the basement. Next, they will set up industrial fans and heaters to dry out the basement area. Drying of the walls in the basement may take several days, depending on the severity of the flooding.
