There are a number of actions one must be careful to avoid doing following water damage. Firstly, it is important to avoid entering a room with standing water until the electricity has been turned off in order to reduce the risk of injury and even death by electrocution. Using a household vacuum to remove water can be dangerous, so it is advised that one wait for a professional to deal with the situation. Tacked down carpet should not be lifted or moved, electrical appliances should not be used, and mold should not be disturbed until the professionals arrive.
