



ED Treatment In Wayne Uses Wave Therapy

Forge Medical Group, based in Wayne, Pennsylvania, has announced that they are offering wave therapy for erectile dysfunction (ED) treatment. Wave therapy has the advantage of being surgery free, drug free, and needle free. It is an evidence-based, alternative treatment for ED. The key to have satisfactory erectile function is to have good blood flow within the erectile tissues. That is what oral medication like Viagra do. Unfortunately, these drugs work only on half of the men who take them and they also have dangerous side effects.

Dr. Borgese, practicing physician at Forge Medical Group, explains, "Instead of dangerous chemical compounds, the wave therapy technique uses pulsed-energy waves to open and repair aging blood vessels and increase blood flow to your penis."

As men get older, the blood vessels that supply blood to the penis start to close up and decay, gradually leading to erectile dysfunction. The gently pulsating waves of wave therapy stimulate the growth of new blood vessels thus increasing blood flow to the penis. With the increase in blood flow, harder, stronger and more sustainable erections can be produced.

In addition, the pulsating waves stimulate a healing response that activates the dormant stem cells and

growth factors in the penis. This results in the creation of new blood vessels and the rejuvenation of erectile tissue.

Dr. Borgese points out that, 80% of men with ED who have received Wave Therapy saw a reversal of their condition, and gave up taking oral ED drugs. And nearly 90% of all men receiving the treatment have reported positive results and improved sexual performance.

It is no wonder that wave therapy is considered to be a revolutionary treatment for ED. It is even effective in men with preexisting conditions. However, carefully choosing the provider is essential. The provider should understand the physiology behind the treatment and the relevant anatomy so that patients can be effectively guided through the treatment process. This is because the therapy requires active participation from the patient.

It is vital for the patient to be actively trying to get erections throughout the treatment process. If necessary other modalities may also be used to assist the patient in getting erections to give the body some time to respond to the therapy.

It is vital to review the medical history and medication list of the patient. While most practices have established a set protocol for all ED patients, that is not the proper approach because each patient is different and the treatment must be tailored to each specific individual. This requires an experienced physician who knows what to look for and how to adjust the treatment appropriately.

The treatment may also vary with regards to the target area and the number and intensity of the pulses. Once again, an experienced physician is needed for this. Also, while the treatment is in progress, changes may be needed with the regards to the strength and frequency of the pulses, plus the targeted area. A thorough understanding of the anatomy is required for this.
