Retainers are needed by those patients whose braces already need to be removed but they still want to retain their results. Retainers are designed to make sure that the teeth and bite remain in proper alignment after years of specialized orthodontic treatment. Without the help of a retainer, the perfectly aligned teeth will gradually move out of alignment.

Retainers can either be fixed retainers or removable retainers. A fixed retainer is a thin wire that is attached to the back of the lower or upper front teeth. This has been observed to provide the best results over the long run because the wire will hold the teeth in perfect alignment day after day. The removable retainer has the advantage of making it easier for patients to clean their teeth. However, removable retainers are easy to lose and their components could get permanently damaged if exposed to extreme heat.

Invisalign is an alternative to metal braces and it has several advantages. First, it is nearly invisible, which means that it is discreet. Second, it does not have wires or brackets, which means it is comfortable to wear. Third, it is removable, which means it can be taken out when eating, drinking, brushing, flossing, and when playing sports. Fourth, it allows the patient to play a sport or musical instrument. And lastly, it requires less office appointments because patients simply switch to a new tray rather than have a dentist adjust the braces.

On the other hand, Invisalign is not suitable for all orthodontics cases. It also cannot be used for kids. It is more costly than the traditional braces and it is easy to lose it. And it may require a longer time to achieve the desired results than with traditional braces.

Traditional metal braces are also provided by Jessica Cohen Orthodontics. The advantages of traditional metal braces include the fact that they are suitable for all treatment types. Metal braces can provide more accurate results compared to Invisalign. Regular braces are also much more affordable. There are several options and colors available. And the treatment time is much shorter.
