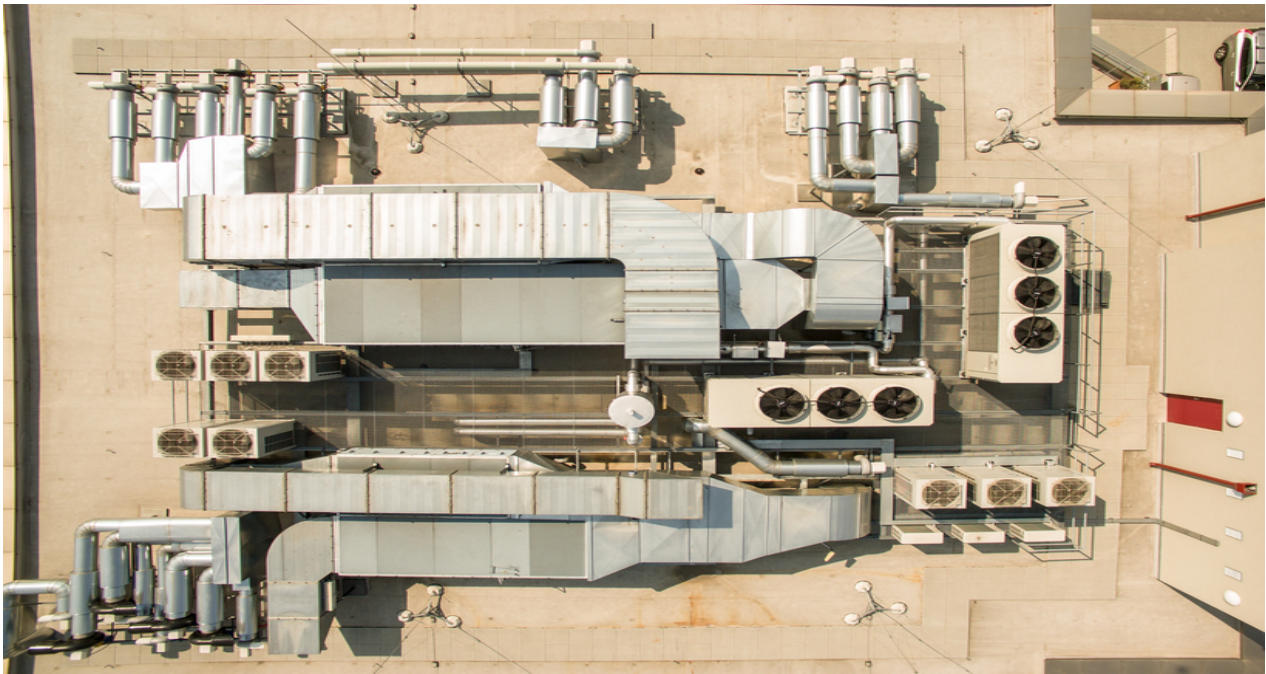




Dynamic Heating and Cooling Offers Advice on How to Make Commercial HVAC Systems More Energy Efficient
