



Organic Fertilizer Provider Recommends Fall Lawn Preparation and Treatment

Jim Wilson, a representative for The Richlawn Company, says, "You might have heard the phrase "fall fertilization is the most important one of the year." That's not a myth. It's the truth, and here's why: from the hottest days of summer to the coldest day in February, your lawn is constantly evolving. As the weather cools and daylight decreases in early fall, turfgrass growth begins to slow and most of the activity takes place out of sight, below the ground. This is the time that the root systems expand and start storing energy for the next season. The thing is, if you don't fertilize your lawn in preparation for the fall, it is much more difficult for your lawn to survive the rigors of our typically dry winters."

According to The Richlawn Company, the first step in fall lawn preparation is to ensure that the lawns are receiving at least an inch of water per week, and the company recommends a deep watering about two times a week instead of a more frequent light watering. According to the company, too much water can actually lead to lawns becoming open to disease.

Wilson says, "The period between the summer to autumn transition is also the time to increase the frequency of your mowing. When you're mowing your lawn, you need to make sure that the grass isn't cut too short—that is, until the final mow of the season, when you do need to leave the grass cut short. The reason for this is that this method is a preventive measure that will protect your grass from potentially being infected by diseases like snow mold over the winter period."

According to Wilson, homeowners should also make sure that their lawns are aerated during the fall. Aeration is a process that involves perforating the soil with small holes so that air, water and nutrients can penetrate the grass roots. Wilson says, "The summer will have caused your lawns to be stressed and the soil will be compacted, with all the heavy footfall. If you don't aerate, your soil can't decompact and get more oxygen, water, and nutrients to the roots, all of which are important in maintaining a healthy lawn."

The company adds that this aeration can and very well should be accompanied by a reseeding session, whether partial or full. They say that the newly created holes will allow the seeds to penetrate the soil properly, take root deeply and get all the nutrients they need. According to Wilson, a reseeding performed along with a thorough aeration will ensure the lawns will remain healthy and hardy from fall all the way through to winter.

Wilson says, "The absolutely key step is to continue fertilizing your lawn throughout the fall. If you use the right organic fertilizer, you can be sure that your lawn will get the amount of nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium that it needs. These three ingredients are the secret to a healthy lawn, and you need to make sure that the fertilizer you use has them in abundance."
