These new guidelines have decreased the definition of high blood pressure to take into consideration complications that can occur at lower numbers and to enable earlier intervention.

According to Paul Whelton, lead author of the new AHA guidelines, "It doesn't mean you need medication, but it's a yellow light that you need to be lowering your blood pressure, mainly with non-drug approaches."

Suzanne explains that in order to measure blood pressure with ease and accuracy, users will need to ensure that the cuff on the wrist is at the same height as the heart. It is also important to stay still while the measurement is ongoing. And there should be no eating or drinking while taking blood pressure measurements.
