To do that, the BPM-317 initiates the measurement process while the blood pressure cuff is still inflating.

It is also important for the users of the BPM-317 to read the manual provided with it and the new AHA guidelines. Incorporated into this new BP monitor is the new threshold for defining high blood pressure. Taking those guidelines into account, the device will indicate whether a person has high blood pressure or not.

In the updated AHA guidelines for the detection, prevention, treatment, and management of high blood pressure, this is now defined as 130/80 mm Hg rather than the previous 140/90 mm Hg. The goal of these new guidelines is to take into account complications that may occur at the lower BP numbers and to allow earlier intervention. Intervention can be in the form of changes in the person?s lifestyle or taking some medication in a number of patients.

Paul Whelton, who was the lead author of the new AHA guidelines, explains, ?It doesn't mean you need medication, but it's a yellow light that you need to be lowering your blood pressure, mainly with non-drug approaches.?

With the new guidelines lowering the numbers that define high blood pressure, it has become more important than ever to monitor a person?s blood pressure. With that in mind, it is also necessary to note that a person?s blood pressure reading can vary throughout the day and it can be influenced by various factors such as the time of day, stress, and even the way the cuff has been wrapped and how the user holds the arm. Users of the BPM-317 also need to familiarize themselves with its manual to ensure that they are using the device correctly.

Suzanne points out that in order to measure a person?s blood pressure with ease and accuracy, it is necessary to ensure that the cuff on the wrist is at the same level as the heart. People should also keep still while the measurement is being taken. And they should not eat or drink during the blood pressure measurement.
