

Cool Sculpting On Stomach Offered In New Jersey

With regards to the recovery time, there is actually no recovery period per se. People would be able

They also would like to point out that it is the ideal solution for both men and women for getting rid of fat bulges. This is because it can target both fibrous and firm fat and it can work on all body types. Before undergoing this treatment of any other treatment, the physician will discuss with the client the various side effects, results and other information regarding the treatment.

For some patients, they might prefer a tummy tuck. However, the tummy tuck involves an invasive and potentially dangerous surgery, so people are advised to consult with reputable physician who provides CoolSculpting in order to make the appropriate comparison.

A tummy tuck is actually a major operation that usually requires one to three hours to complete. After that, the patient will need to wait for an additional two weeks before being able to resume sedentary work and up to one month before exercising or doing more rigorous physical activities. In contrast, CoolSculpting treatment will only take 30 to 60 minutes. And after the treatment is completed, the patient can immediately return to normal activities. Having no downtime, CoolSculpting is ideal for people who have limited time available. In fact, some people would opt to have the procedure done during lunch or after work. For those who have a substantial amount of loose and sagging skin, a tummy tuck may be preferred. CoolSculpting alone will not be able to remove extra skin.

In terms of budget, CoolSculpting would be preferable as it will only cost between \$750 and \$1,500 per treatment. This amount will depend on the size of the area and the physician, number of applicators, and the geographic location. On the other hand, a tummy tuck will cost between \$3,000 and \$12,000, depending on the clinic, surgeon, geographic location, the amount of skin to get rid of, and whether the patient has to spend time in the hospital for recovery.

There are many other possible target areas for CoolSculpting, aside from the stomach. These include the arms, thighs, breasts, buttocks, and the submental or chin area.
