People are understandably reluctant to visit a gastroenterology clinic or endoscopy center. However, a stomach specialist is the one who is best equipped for diagnosing and treating the broadest range of symptoms related to the gastrointestinal tract. Dr. DaCosta wants to emphasize that early detection is critical to make sure that the condition can be treated before it becomes irreversible. A gastroenterologist will discuss the patients? condition with their regular doctor in order to ensure a supportive and continuous treatment plan.

Regular physicians will refer patients to gastroenterologists when they require routine tests or particular procedures. These include colonoscopy, capsule endoscopy, hemorrhoid ablation, upper endoscopy, and anorectal manometry.

Colonoscopy is commonly performed on patients over the age of 45 to test for colorectal cancer. It can also be used to test for polyps. Capsule endoscopy uses a small camera to take photos inside the patient?s digestive system. Here, the camera is placed inside a capsule and is swallowed by the patient. Hemorrhoid ablation makes use of infrared light to heal hemorrhoids. Upper endoscopy is used to check on the esophagus and other parts of the upper gastrointestinal tract. In anorectal manometry, the muscles of the anus and rectum are examined to find the causes of fecal incontinence.

Patients of the Gastro Center NJ have mostly positive things to say about the clinic. For instance, James K. said, ?I?ve had sporadic stomach cramps and gassiness for as long as I can remember. For the longest time, I was convinced I had colon cancer. I went to Dr. DaCosta and he screened me immediately. The results
