One of the services offered at the Gastroenterologist Center Of New Jersey is colonoscopy. Dr. DaCosta wants to point out that 1 in 19 men and 1 in 21 women develop colon cancer. That is why colonoscopy is highly recommended, especially for those who are more than 45 years old. Dr. DaCosta also wants to stress that people should not be afraid because when detected early, colon cancer can be eliminated and even avoided completely. A colonoscopy would also be able to help determine the underlying causes of various conditions, including rectal bleeding, cramps, lower abdominal pain, anemia, incontinence, unusual bowel habits, long-lasting diarrhea, and weight loss.

Also offered at the Gastroenterologist Center Of New Jersey is upper endoscopy. This is performed as an outpatient service and is used when the symptoms suggest abnormalities in the stomach, esophagus, and the first portion of the duodenum, which is where the small intestine starts. All of these form the upper digestive tract. Symptoms that indicate the need to perform upper endoscopy include pain in the abdomen or chest, heartburn, bleeding, trouble swallowing, nausea, weight loss, anemia, and vomiting.

Upper endoscopy is also much more reliable for detecting conditions in the upper digestive tract, such as cancer, compared to X-rays. During the procedure, polyps can be discovered and removed and biopsies may be taken for testing. Meanwhile, any areas that have been narrowed by conditions like cancer in the esophagus, stomach and duodenum can be expanded through the use of medical devices like balloons. When strictures are discovered during an upper endoscopy, a stent may also be used to hold it open.

Patients have been very satisfied with the treatment they have received. For example, Ryan J. said, "I originally scheduled a colonoscopy for my mother of 67 years. After meeting with Dr. DaCosta and seeing how comfortable my mum was, I decided to grab the opportunity and get one done myself.
