The informational blog on their website goes on to say that the first way people can detect the presence of mold in their HVAC system is from the terrible odor that comes from it as it builds up in an air conditioning unit. When this happens, mold produces a very a musty, wet, stale or rotten smell. This foul smell will most likely be noticeable in the rooms of a house when the air condition portion of an HVAC system is running.

Another way to detect the possibility that an air conditioning system is contaminated with mold is by how the occupants of a house react physically to it. It was mentioned that mold is both an allergen and respiratory irritant. Mold when it builds up in an HVAC system can cause such respiratory problems as wheezing, congestion and throat irritation. It is also known to cause headaches, nausea and itchy eyes. So if any family members are showing signs of these bodily reactions, then that homeowner should have their HVAC system checked for mold buildup. Even family pets can show signs of these respiratory and bodily health issues.

The third way to detect mold buildup in an air conditioning unit is through a thorough visual inspection of that unit. A person can inspect their air conditioning unit for mold by simply removing the grille cover of their outside air conditioning unit. Mold shows up as streaks or clusters of brown, black, or greenish stains on the surface of internal air conditioning unit parts. There is no getting around it, if ones sees this in the air conditioning system, it's important to take steps to eradicate that mold or suffer the health and odor consequences.
