If someone is not hospitalized but has a prescription for a back brace from their doctor, Medicare B will cover 80% to 100% of the cost of the back brace. The company further states that Medicare B covers arm, leg, back, and neck braces. Once someone has the prescription from their doctor, they will need to purchase the brace through a provider that is Medicare-certified.
