

Shower Meister Shares Information On How To Choose Shower Filters

The company specializes in all types of bathroom equipment, having worked with such products for over 15 years before starting their blog.

In their most recent blog entry, ShowerMeister seeks to address a common concern regarding the selection of shower filters among their reader base. Mike Chrest, a spokesperson for the company, states, "There are several shower filters with varying qualities and each of them have their distinct uses. Some are better at removing odors than they are at removing chlorine, while others only filter a small selection of substances but are significantly more convenient. Each of them serves a purpose but you will not know which is the best option just by looking at them unless you are an expert."

While shower filters are not always necessary, the company asserts that they are the best option for people who want to ensure that their water is clean. This is especially true for those who live where the water is polluted, and avoiding a water filter may not be an option. Regardless of what leads to the necessity of a filter, there are several aspects to consider before choosing one for a home, such as what needs to be filtered, where it comes from, and how polluted the water is. ShowerMeister published their list of the 5 Best Shower Filters for Hard Water based on these considerations.

The first item reviewed in their article is the APEX MR-7011 S. Despite its simplistic design, this model excels in eliminating almost all toxic fumes and guaranteeing that there will be no bad odors once the filter is installed. It is also one of the easiest models to install, fitting into most modern showerheads. However, it has a lifetime of 12 to 16 months of constant use, which, combined with its high price, may make it a sub-optimal choice for those on a tight budget.

The second filter reviewed by ShowerMeister is the SPRITE HO2-WH-M. It comes from a very famous and

reputable manufacturer, which effectively means that the quality of this filter is virtually guaranteed. One feature that differentiates this filter from others is that it comes with a massaging head, which can be removed or replaced with any other showerhead (as it is compatible with most models on the market). While this filter is effective at removing water odor, it is not as good removing the chlorine. On the other hand, it can be easily installed and removed, making it convenient to take on trips.

Another option reviewed in the article is the Aqua Elegante Filter. Compared to other filters, this is a more aesthetically luxurious option that manages not to compromise on cleansing ability in favor of its looks. It possesses a filtering system that, despite being quite simple, produces the best filtering results, excelling at removing around 90 to 95% of the water's chlorine. The wide array of features it boasts makes it one of the best options for its price range, falling behind only two other filters reviewed by the company.

The next item reviewed by ShowerMeister before their top choice is the Aquasana AQ-4100, one of the most popular filters on the market. Its filtration system makes it the best choice for people who are struggling with hair and skin health, as it removes up to 90% of the water's chlorine as well as several other substances. One notable thing about this model is that it has cartridges that can be replaced at a price that is significantly lower than it would be if the entire filter had to be changed every few years. For people who live in an area where the water is remarkably bad, this is the best filter available.
