The user simply points it at the forehead of a baby or child at a distance of two to six inches to determine the body temperature within just two seconds. Furthermore, iProven has ensured that it is sturdy and reliable so that people can always rely on the readings from this thermometer. And they can take reading after reading and be sure it will always function properly, that is, provide accurate temperature readings. It even has a 100 days money back guarantee, which means that customers who are not satisfied with it can simply return it within 100 days after purchase, no questions asked.

What is more is that the NCT-336 BL non-contact thermometer can be used to measure the temperature of just about anything. Parents who are worried that the feeding bottle is too hot can check its temperature by simply putting the thermometer to Object Mode and then pointing it at the bottle from a distance of two to six inches. When worried about the baby's bath being too hot or too cold, parents can simply point it at the bath from a distance of two to six inches, click on it and the temperature of the bath is provided. It can also be used to measure room temperature, for parents who are worried that their babies might find it uncomfortable.

Also, the NCT-336 BL is convenient to use, particularly for babies and young kids. Parents know how irritable little ones can get if they are sick or not feeling well. But because there is no need to touch the young ones with the thermometer and because it can provide an accurate reading within two seconds, parents struggling to take the temperature of fussy babies and little tots are a thing of the past. Another important feature is that the color of the display will change into yellow if the temperature is elevated and into red if there is a fever. There will also be an alarm, except when the mute function is on, so that parents are immediately alerted if there is a fever so that they can take the appropriate action.
