The display lighting is green if the baby's temperature is normal. Thus, if the display is green after taking the measurement, parents can heave a sigh of relief and go back to sleep.

On the other hand, if the display is red, the baby has a fever and parents will have to take the necessary actions like bringing the baby to the doctor. This is particularly important with the flu activity expected to increase by October and November.
