area is considered a free-flowing section of the Columbia River because it is the longest stretch between dams, making it flow like a normal river. The only difference? and the biggest challenge? here is the water's level, which can fluctuate from 3-6 feet in a single day.

The company notes that their Hanford Reach Fishing Guides begin at the start of the season, where they focus on covering a fishing method called "Down Hill Trolling," or "Down River Trolling." The method itself consists of flowing along with the current, and it is proven to cover a bigger area in a faster time than any other method, producing the best results as well. However, this method works best while the fish are traveling, and the company says that they switch their methods accordingly as the season progresses.

"It is all about using the right method at the right time," notes Wyatt. "While this region is one of the most challenging, we can guarantee successful fishing sessions by adapting to the situation. While others have failed here, we have continued to prove our expertise and adaptability over the years, obtaining the best results and maintaining a great fishing experience for our attendees."

During the second part of the season, the company states that they change their fishing methods to back trolling eggs and plugs. They also focus on the spawning point, where these fall Chinook Salmons will be more dominant, in preparation for the fish?s mating season. The salmon are noticeably bigger during this period, often pushing or exceeding 50 pounds.

Reel Time Fishing is one of the most distinguished fishing guide companies in the area, having served the community for several years and developed a stable of outstanding skills in the same period.
