Next, the fully adhered EPDM membrane offers a level of protection that surpasses that of traditional coatings and it doesn't require fasteners or primers. In addition to the TTR® system's environmental benefits, more energy savings can be attained through the use of photovoltaic cells and roof top landscapes that can be installed over the system with complete warranty. The system can also be provided with a black membrane or white energy star rated membrane.
