



I Proven Announces That FL 35 Ovulation Home Test Strips Are Now In Stock

These test strips can be used by women trying to conceive (TTC) for monitoring their fertility. These strips are designed to test for the presence of the luteinizing hormone (LH) in the urine. By following the step-by-step instructions in the manual, women who are trying to conceive would be able to determine when they are fertile and therefore when to do the baby dance.

When using the test strips, women who are TTC should collect their urine in a clean container and then dip the strips for five seconds. After 3 minutes, they can read the results. However, interpreting the results is not that simple. Each female body is different from the others. Testers will need to comply with the step-by-instructions that have been provided in the manual.

For some women, they will have a positive LH test during their whole cycle. The only distinction is that their second line will become darker when the day of their ovulation approaches. Other women will only see a faint second line appear during ovulation day, which is when they experience their LH surge. No matter what the case, women will get to know how to interpret the results for their own specific body. What is important is that

they get to know when they are fertile so that they can do the baby dance and possibly get pregnant.

Especially if things don't go as quickly as you'd hoped for. Whether you just started your TTC journey, or you're on the road for a little bit longer, reliable ovulation test strips are a must. That's why we developed this fertility monitor kit. The strips in our ovulation test kit have an accuracy of 99%."

Suzanne points out that they recommend that women who are TTC should try testing twice a day in order to be able to pinpoint the exact moment of their ovulation. With as many as 35 test strips in the FL-35 kit, this can be easily done.

It is important to note that during the whole 28 days of a woman's cycle, there are only a few days when a woman can become pregnant. This usually happens 12 to 14 days before the next cycle starts. That is why it is vital to determine those fertile days so that women who are trying to conceive can do the baby dance on those days to have the highest possibility of getting pregnant.

Meanwhile, the FL-35 also includes two pregnancy test strips. Naturally, after tracking their ovulation doing the baby dance, women who are TTC will need to check if their efforts have born fruit. These pregnancy test strips are over 99 percent accurate. The tests are to be done on cycle day one, which is the first day of the next menstrual cycle. The tester simply dips the pregnancy test strip into the container that contains the urine for five seconds. The results will then appear after 3 to 5 minutes. The first thing to look for is the control line because if there is none, the test is invalid and the tester will need to repeat the test using another test strip. If there is a control line but no other line, then the results are negative. But if there are two lines, the results indicate that the tester is pregnant and that it is time to celebrate.
