He further advises that, "There are many questions to ask and many issues to consider. An investigation into any one or a combination of these issues is pretty much necessary to protect the welfare of your child. As Mason explains, child custody cases are often emotional and expensive affairs. Courts prefer that parents work out a custody arrangement between themselves. In cases where the parents cannot come to an agreement, the judges will make the decision for the parents, who must adhere to the judge's order. Mason says, "One thing you can be sure of is that South Carolina judges who preside on child custody cases always look out for the best interest of the child. Even if divorcing parents manage to come up with their own custody arrangements, a judge will review it to make sure that the arrangement ensures the safety and welfare of the child in question."
