Molds can cause allergic reactions in susceptible people, especially for the very young and the elderly, whose immune systems may not be strong enough. This could result in respiratory problems. Some types of mold can even cause suppression of the immune system or cause certain types of cancer.

The problem with mold is that it is difficult to see it, particularly if it is growing behind walls or in other places not often seen by the people living in the home, like under roofing shingles. Fortunately, mold may be detected by smell because it has a unique musty odor that is easily recognizable. People may also experience physical symptoms like a rash, headaches, eye irritation, and even asthma, and these may indicate that there is a mold problem in the home. If these signs are present, it would be advisable to call for professional mold testing. Problems with a leaky roof, leaky pipes or accumulation of moisture may also be indicative of the potential presence of mold.

Homeowners may want to be on the lookout for the physical symptoms of mold contamination. These include skin rashes and itching, eye irritation, congestion, asthma or aggravation of existing asthma, lung infection, flu-like symptoms that won't go away, fatigue, respiratory dysfunction, dizziness, frequent and excessive nose bleeds, vomiting, headaches, and bladder or urinary tract infections. The health impact of molds may range from the very mild to the very severe, even requiring hospitalization. One way that people can find out if their symptoms are related to the home they are living in is to go on a vacation and see if the symptoms disappear.
