This is a scaling tool for pipes missing the invert. It can also be used to clean up reinstatements and to clean all scaled pipes in plastic or cast iron. This is a patent pending tool and is designed to replace all chains, sanding blocks, and other tools for pipes missing the invert.

The Typhoon is a scaling tool that is suitable for pipes missing the invert and it can also be utilized to clean up pipe reinstatements and all scaled pipes, whether these are made of plastic or cast iron."

Aside from the patent pending Typhoon scaling tool, Hurricane Reinstatement Solutions also offers another patented tool, which is the Tornado Reinstatement Cutter. The Tornado is capable of reopening a damaged pipe in under 45 seconds.

Hurricane Reinstatement Solutions is a provider of pipe reinstatement tools. These are tools that allow plumbers to access damaged subterranean pipes without having to dig trenches. Their specialty is lateral pipe reinstatement, which is the procedure by which the connections between the main pipe and the service lateral pipes are reopened. This will allow storm or sewage drainage systems to perform their appropriate functions again.

The procedure for lateral reinstatement has improved significantly through the years. In the 1970s, pipe re-liners had to use very short sections of pipe with precise measurements. It required a lot of time, mostly because even the smallest errors would require a rework. It was only in the 1980s that the reinstatement cutters became available in the market. These had power motors that allowed the cutters to cut holes, grind debris, and cut a smooth opening in the pipe.

Mike Gesty also points out that, while other cutters are usually only capable of reinstating 35 to 40 feet of pipe in a day, The Tornado is capable of easily reinstating 70 feet or more in under a minute. It has also been observed to have the capability of creating an oval hole in all kinds of pipes, while requiring little or no sanding. This particular cutter has been found to be a game changer because standard reinstatement cutters required 15 to 45 minutes to finish the job. In contrast, the Tornado Reinstatement Cutter completes the same job in just 30 to 45 seconds.

They also make use of the cured-in-place pipe, which is a trenchless rehabilitation technique. This is usually performed by inserting a fiberglass cloth or polyester felt tube saturated in resin into the damaged pipe. After just one day, the resin will have cured, offering a tight-fitting and corrosion resistant pipe within the damaged pipe.

And now, with the new Typhoon pipe scaling tool, plumbers will find it easier to repair scaled pipes and clean reinstated pipes. Pipe scale is the material that accumulates on the inside of pipes, thus reducing the inner diameter of the pipe. This may mean that the volume of water is reduced or the pressure is increased, resulting in other problems. With the Typhoon scaling tool, all scales in the pipes can be removed in a matter of seconds. And, just like the Tornado reinstatement cutter, the Typhoon tool is available in diameters of 2 inches, 3 inches, 4 inches, and 6 inches.

Hurricane Reinstatement Solutions is a locally owned and operated company in Tucson.
