As noted on the Brady Brady & Reilly, LLC website, "According to the New Jersey Department of Transportation, 278,413 total crashes occurred in 2018 compared to a total of 271,809 total vehicle accidents in 2017. Additionally, most car accidents in New Jersey occur on municipal or country roads. Rear-end

accidents are the most common type of accident. Rear-end accidents account for about 24% of accidents in New Jersey. They conclude, "All of these types of accidents are very dangerous and can result in injuries that range from minor bruises and cuts to catastrophic injuries."

"Not every accident will put you in the hospital, but even minor car crashes can be greatly irritating," notes the firm. "Car accidents of all kinds happen on a daily basis all over New Jersey, and each crash can cost the vehicle owners involved thousands of dollars to carry out repairs alone. While some drivers may be willing to pay the price for this accident out of pocket, even without an insurance provider's help, the firm points out that most will not have this privilege."

"Given how many people live paycheck to paycheck, it is conceivable that a surprise expense will severely restrict their finances," says the Toms River auto accident attorney. "If the vehicle in question is put out of commission for an extended period because they cannot afford the mechanic's bill, this may also mean they have a less convenient way of making their daily commute to work. Inconveniences like this nonetheless tend to take a toll that accident victims do not notice."

The firm continues, "However, this is all at the lightest end of the scale. More severe road accidents can result in harsh injuries that in turn lead to heavier consequences down the line. For instance, being hospitalized may force them to leave their place of employment for an extended period, a situation that leaves the victim unable to pay of the excessive bills they will likely accrue.
