Ogden Utah Water Damage Cleanup Performed By The Flood Co.

water damage remediation contractor and get a technician to inspect the home or property as soon as possible even if the severity of the damages incurred is not yet known. The sooner the better for technicians to be able to assess the damages, and the better chances for restoring the property back to the "pre-loss condition" in a shorter period of time.

In the case of the project that The Flood Co. was recently involved, much water has already seeped in through the windows, causing damage to various belongings in the home in the ground floor. Things that got wet, even those that were not visibly wet, had to be dried like the carpet and various furniture items. Thus, they were removed from the area and placed in an area where they can get dry. Then, the water that got in had to be removed and the rooms in the ground floor had to be made dry using blowers. After that, they checked for visible signs of mold and performed the mold removal procedure where it was needed. Tests were made to check for mold and cleaning was continued until the levels that are considered to be safe were reached.

In cases of water damage, Daryl Olsen advises homeowners and property owners not to hire their insurance company's preferred vendor. This is due to a number of reasons regarding response time, loyalty, delays, accountability, the fact that some insurance companies do not cover mold, convenience, and disagreement between insurance firms on the standards for drying. And the preferred vendor of an insurance firm usually has instructions from the firm about questions that they can answer and what they can say. There are often not in a position to advise the homeowner or property owner on some topics. Meanwhile, The Flood Co. also provides other kinds of services. These include smoke and fire damage services and mold damage services, including mold testing.
