In fact, health experts believe that approximately one in six people who suffer from allergies do so as a direct result of fungi and bacteria in their air duct system, so it is crucial to have an HVAC system cleaned regularly. Besides health considerations, a clean and well-maintained HVAC system also operates more efficiently and helps conserve energy. Furthermore, dust and dirt trapped in the air ducts are the primary causes of major system breakdowns, so it pays to have a regular cleaning schedule to save more money in the long run.

Daryl Olsen from All Clean Air Duct Cleaning explains that homeowners should schedule an air duct cleaning

once every 2-3 years. However, the frequency can vary if there are smokers in the household, pets that shed high amounts of hair and dander, water leakage, and residents with allergies or asthma. They also recommend air duct cleaning prior to occupancy of a new home and after having home renovations.

On the other hand, Olsen warns the general public about a number of air duct cleaning companies in the area with offers that are "too good to be true". He explains that the normal rate of air duct cleaning for a house with a single furnace ranges between \$300 to \$600, and anything below or above that price range is considered unreasonable. He also advises homeowners to be wary of companies who offer "free mold inspections" because they tend to find mold in the ductwork of virtually every home. They will usually offer to decontaminate the entire house by fogging with mildewcides that can cost an additional few hundred dollars. Furthermore he points out that a full air duct cleaning process usually takes at least two hours. If a company says that they can do it faster, they most likely deliver a substandard service.
