In simple terms, rhinoplasty is a surgical procedure used to modify the shape or contours of the nose. As the nose is built on a combination of bone, cartilage, and skin tissue, a skilled surgeon can manipulate a patient's nose during surgery to achieve a more aesthetically pleasing appearance. At The Rhinoplasty Center, lead plastic surgeon Dr. Aaron Kosins specializes in performing such procedures with exacting detail, delivering the perfect look his patients are searching for. He relies on a combination of skill and cutting edge surgical techniques to minimize recovery time as much as possible.

Dr. Kosins states that, "If you want to address the size, shape or proportions of your nose, we encourage you to schedule an appointment at your earliest convenience. Rhinoplasty may be a relatively simple procedure compared to other types of plastic surgery, but any operation carries a measure of risk. Due to this, you can

rest assured that we will go over all the adjustments you want made in order to ensure you remain well informed. In turn, this will help you get more comfortable with the changes long before you step into our practice for your actual procedure. The consultation, according to Dr. Kosins, is one of the most important stages of the patient's journey.

Since the clinic often sees new patients who have yet to undergo their first procedure, they are keen to share details of what patients may expect during their consultations. First and foremost, their surgeon will require a full workup of their medical history. "We like to begin by inquiring after your reasons for the procedure," says Dr. Kosins. "At this stage, we can learn whether you're seeking rhinoplasty for cosmetic or medical purposes; this will help us decide where to take the consultation as we move forward. There are also certain health conditions that make rhinoplasty unwise, so it's our job to make sure you qualify as a candidate before we proceed."

The consultation also involves a complete physical exam, with particular emphasis placed on the patient's facial features (including the inside of the nose). Patients should be aware that this stage will likely involve a degree of laboratory testing as well. These tests, combined with an examination of the physical structure of the patient's skin and other features, help the surgeon build an accurate assessment of what the patient can expect from their procedure, including the estimated length of their recovery period. Those considering their first procedure may reach out to the clinic to learn more.

Rhinoplasty is used to correct a number of deformities in the nose, regardless of their origin. Dr. Kosins explains, "Many patients present with noses that they were simply born with and would prefer in a different shape, but it can be used to correct other problems as well. For instance, some of our patients seek rhinoplasty to help correct breathing issues caused by nasal obstructions. Others come to us seeking the best rhinoplasty surgeons they can find because they suffered an accident and need reconstructive surgery performed on their nose. Whatever their reasons," he clarifies, "we welcome any and all patients who wish to see the best version of themselves when they look in the mirror."

In any situation, patients can always expect the highest standards of care at The Rhinoplasty Center, as well as the attention of one of the best plastic surgeons in the region.
