Tubal Ligation Reversal Specialist Allows Women To Get Pregnant Again

A tubal ligation reversal specialist Georgia residents can rely on has announced that they can help women get pregnant again. Tubal ligation reversal is an operation that allows a woman who has had tubal ligation to try and get pregnant again. The Lakeshore Surgical Center in Gainesville, Georgia, has already performed thousands of tubal reversals on women from various parts of the world. The surgical operation is performed in two steps. The first step involves accessing the Fallopian tubes through a small incision and the second step is to rejoin the separated ends of the tubes.

Dr. William Greene, Jr., M.D., the Medical Director at the Lakeshore Surgical Center, explains, "If you have had your tubes "tied" and you want to have another baby, you may be a candidate for tubal ligation reversal. Many patients who have been told they should have IVF (In Vitro Fertilization) actually have better chances of getting pregnant with less invested and less risk with tubal ligation reversal. We cannot emphasize this enough."

Those who undergo the tubal ligation reversal procedure are expected to be able to work 3 to 4 days after the surgery, unless they perform heavy physical work in their jobs. Dr. Green says, "Serious problems are very

rare; one doctor has reported doing almost 300 cases with no serious problems. If you have had a tubal ligation procedure but you now want to get pregnant again, we suggest that you schedule an appointment or come to our tubal ligation reversal office to fully understand the procedure.?

Those who decide to come to the Lakeshore Surgical Center for outpatient tubal ligation reversal will have to come the afternoon of the day before the surgery so that they can meet the staff and have the requisite papers and lab work completed.

The physicians at Lakeshore Surgical Center utilize a careful surgical technique in order to ensure the success of the procedure. They will take each layer as it comes, controlling even the small amounts of bleeding, ensuring that the tissues are moist, and applying very tiny sutures. Each layer is provided with a local anesthetic to ensure that the patient is more comfortable while she is recovering.

After the tubal ligation reversal surgery is completed, the patient can rest in the center for about an hour, after which she can leave. They will then see the patient in the morning to ensure that there are no issues and they will continue to call on the patient at home during the recovery period and even after that, from time to time.

Some patients may be worried that the tubal ligation procedure that was performed on them cannot be reversed. Nevertheless, Dr. Greene points out that they will still need to look at the tubal ligation operative note that was dictated by the doctor when he or she performed the tubal ligation. Some methods that appear to be irreversible didn't actually do much damage to the Fallopian tubes.

Meanwhile, Lakeshore Surgical Center was the first to reverse an Essure Tubal Ligation on November 5, 2007. This is significant in view of the reported inability to reverse Essures because they are supposed to be permanent and impossible to reverse. In the Essure procedure, coils of Nitinol are placed in the tubes where they enter the uterus. The coils are very fragile and have to be carefully removed during Essure reversal so that they don't break apart. Because if the coils break apart, the physician will have to retrieve all of the pieces and ensure that there are no pieces left behind.

Lakeshore Surgical Center has focused on outpatient gynecologic procedures since 1991. Dr. Greene obtained his medical degree from the University of Miami and finished his residency in obstetrics and gynecology at the University of Miami Jackson Memorial Hospital. He underwent postgraduate training in microsurgery at M.D. Anderson hospital in Houston, Texas, and the Moet Institute in San Francisco.
