Across Colorado and the United States, rates of opioid addiction and overdose are devastating communities, families, and individuals. Colorado recorded 543 opioid overdose deaths in 2018. Only a third of those who need treatment in Colorado actually get it. Emergency rooms, jails, and shelters are overwhelmed handling the vast majority of individual addiction-related and mental health crisis situations.

Despite 300 annual days of sun, a booming economy and an unparalleled reputation for physical fitness, Colorado's residents rank among the most mentally ill people in the country. It's estimated that about 20 percent of the state's adult population – about 832,000 people – is living with some kind of mental health condition, according to a 2019 report from Mental Health America, and nearly 450,000 of them aren't being treated for that illness.
