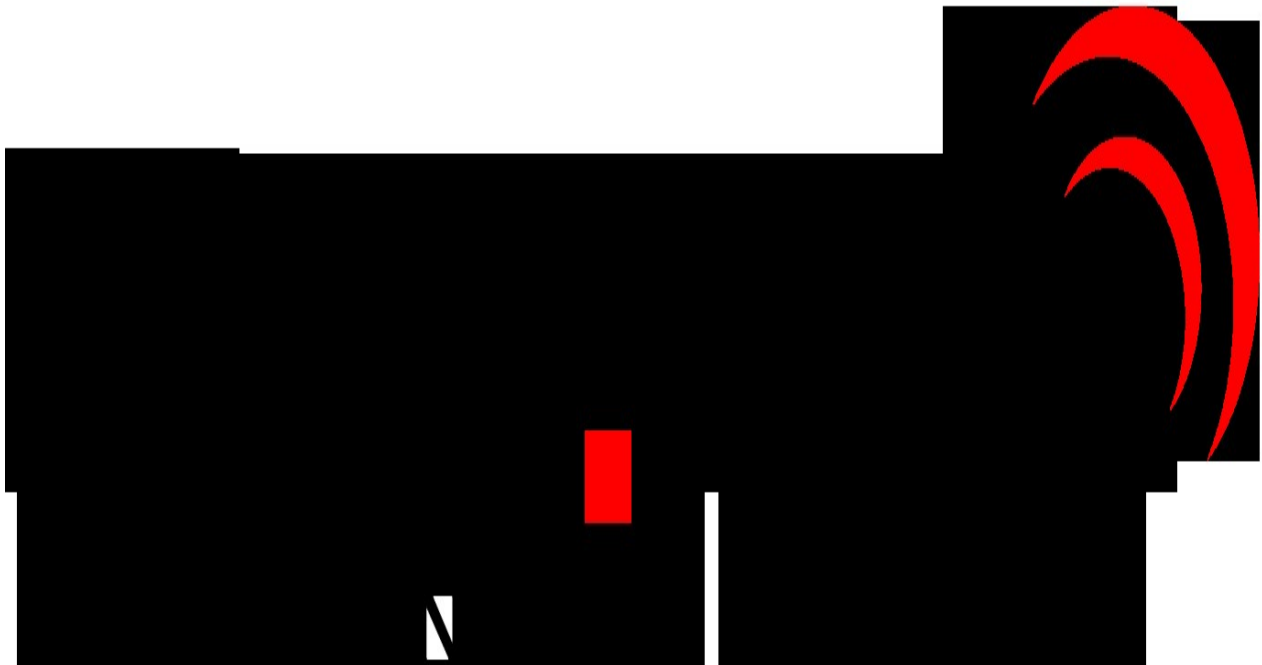




Long Term Care Services Providers About to be Swamped - Strategic Case Management Book Now Available On Amazon For Kindle
