Mold grows on literally any substance and appears when moisture, particularly excessive moisture, is

present. Initially, only a small amount of mold may be visible, and it may not appear significant. What is visible may only be the tip of the iceberg and the problem may be bigger than it appears. Mold spores are responsible for causing many health problems and although adverse reactions are minor for some, they can be significant for others. Mold exposures can have a wide variety of adverse health effects, the severity of which will depend on the individual concerned. Throat irritation, eye irritation, coughing, wheezing, nasal issues, and skin irritation are all considered normal reactions to mold.

Mold should always be taken seriously because what is visible may hide a much greater problem underneath. Mold on the surface of wallpaper, for example, may not look much, but remove that wallpaper and it may reveal a major infestation. It is vital to fully assess any appearance of mold. If the mold is significant, such as mold resulting from flooding, whether just a single room or the whole house is affected, the problem can be far more dangerous because abnormally high levels of mold spores may be present. Some of those molds can be especially dangerous and exposure can lead to life-threatening conditions.

Professional attention is an absolute must when mold appears. St. Louis Cleaning and Restoration specializes in mold removal and remediation services. Over the years the company has established a professional routine to deal with mold. The routine starts with an inspection and an assessment of the problem. Once that has happened and the cost estimate has been agreed to by the client, work can begin.

Health and safety are of paramount importance and the next step includes the construction of containment barriers. This is done to prevent the further spread of mold spores. Contents from the affected areas are then sealed and removed to the company's specialized cleaning and restoration area.

If there is mold within an air system, it will be cleaned with proprietary equipment and treated with an anti-microbial solution. The premises will then be ready for reconstruction.
