Childproof outlets look much like standard electrical outlets but they will have spring-loaded receptacle cover plates which are installed to cover the electrical contacts. These plates will prevent any insertion when there is unequal pressure applied on the receptacles, which will act as a barrier and prevent small children from inserting random objects into the outlet. However, these outlets do not require any additional effort to be used by adults as insertion of a plug only requires that equal pressure is applied on all receptacle plates.

According to statistics shared by Failsafe Electric Company, about 30% of accidents involving children and electrical outlets involve the insertion of common household objects. Making matters worse, about 70% of such accidents occur in the presence of an adult. The electrician says that the most common items that are inserted into the electrical outlets are small metal things children can easily get their hands on, such as keys, hairpins, jewelry, nail files, knives, belt buckles, staples, paperclips, and other similar items.

Lopez says, "Having childproof outlets in your home is certainly an upgrade. They only cost slightly more than the standard outlets but the result is that you, your kids and your family can all rest assured that there will be no unfortunate accidents." Childproof electrical outlets have actually proven to be so highly effective such that the National Electrical Code has required that all new homes be fitted with these outlets since 2008. Childproof electrical outlets reduce the risk of electric shocks, electrical burns and fatal injuries.

"When you are shopping for childproof outlets, there are certain products that you should keep away from," Lopez advises. "These include any and all products that require screwing of plugs because they will be an inconvenience and will increase fire risks. You also need to keep away from low quality products because they will not last long and might malfunction. If you don't know how to find the right childproof outlets, you should get in touch with a licensed electrician, who can also help install the childproof outlets safely.
