All contractors are required to have Type III certification, permitting them to

service and dispose of low-pressure appliances. Finally, they require HVAC companies to have A/C Technical Training | HVACCEC-10266, Furnace Training | HVACCEC-10265 and Heat Pump Training | HVACCEC-10268.

Meanwhile, plumbing contractors who are invited to join the website?s ranks must hold a Master Plumber Contractor License awarded by the state. To obtain the license, plumbers must show a significant number of years of work experience, including time working under a Master Plumber. Additionally, plumbing contractors must complete at least six hours of continuing education and training each year to ensure that their methods and equipment are up to date.
