

Minneapolis, MN Law Firm Sheds Light On White Collar Crimes

Ryan Garry, founder of Ryan Garry LLC, said, "White collar crimes refer to crimes that generally do not involve violence, such as forgery, fraud, identity theft and embezzlement, but they can be as every bit as complex as any other class of crime. If you're dealing with white collar crimes, it's very important that you hire an attorney that has extensive experience in the field as well as the resources necessary to accurately analyze the large quantities of documents that usually come with these types of cases. You will also do well to learn all that you can about it."

In a recent blog post, the law firm explored the different types of white collar crimes, the first of which was mail theft—the act of intentionally taking mail owned by or intended for someone else (and without permission from a mailbox or a mail carrier), which carries a sentence of up to 3 years in prison and/or up to a \$5,000 fine. Forgery, using a knowingly false writing for identification or recommendation, for example, is also a white collar crime, and carries a sentence of up to 3 years in prison and/or up to a \$5,000 fine.

The law firm further went on to describe another type of white collar crime: check forgery—falsely creating or changing a check or falsely endorsing a check or trying to pay with a forged check. According to Ryan Garry LLC, check forgery carries a sentence of up to 20 years in prison and/or up to a \$100,000 fine, depending on the amount of the check or the amount of whatever is trying to be obtained.

The blog post also looked into a number of other white collar crimes. In the post, Garry said, "Federal forgery and counterfeiting, for example, is governed by 18 U.S.C. §§ 470-514. If you deal in counterfeit obligations or

securities, you could be sentenced to up to 20 years in prison and/or a fine under 18 U.S.C. § 473. If you make or possess counterfeit dies, molds, or such items for making coins, you could be sentenced to up to 15 years in prison and/or a fine under 18 U.S.C. § 487. If you falsely make, forge, or alter a deed, receipt, or any other writing to get money from the United States or its agents, you could be sentenced to up to 10 years in prison and/or a fine under 18 U.S.C. § 495. If you knowingly remove, destroy, or alter the VIN on a car, you could be sentenced to up to 5 years in prison and/or a fine under 18 U.S.C. § 511.
