Even natural pearls that have formed by accident don't come from the mythical grain of sand but from a disturbance or break in the mantle layer of the shell that dislodges a few cells from the mantle tissue of the mollusk. These cells then multiply and form a pearl sac. The pearl grows inside this sac, as the mantle tissue continues to secrete pearl forming nacre in this enclosed area. Any foreign object that has been

introduced by the disturbance will be coated by the nacre, and the layers of nacre will form around it. But sand is incapable of penetrating the oyster shell. Sometimes a parasite may do so.

Miriam Reed of Pearl Distributors, which is known for being a leading online retailer of quality pearl jewelry noted: "For many years, people have believed myths about pearls and how they are grown. I have heard them all but despite published information, this one just will not go away."
