We caution against non-professionals trying to remove broken off keys themselves because many times the lock that the broken key fragment is stuck in gets damage during the DIY key removal process.?

Nystrom also said that their locksmiths are so experienced that they consider broken key removal to be a fairly simple and straightforward process. He also estimates that 95% of the time a key gets broken off in an auto lock, it?s not caused by a lock problem but by a problem with the key itself. Nystrom says that when a car owner damages their vehicles lock in an attempt to remove a broken key, many times they have just created a much more complicated and more expensive vehicle lock repair. Nystrom did add that in the event of a worst-case scenario where a car key does need replacing, they still can resolve this for the customer on location. He says the locksmiths at the company are very talented when it comes to doing entire car lock replacements too.

One other big benefit that Nystrom mentioned that people get from having their broken car keys removed by a locksmith like The Key Guys, is that they are a 100% mobile vehicle locksmith services provider.
