Notably, there are a variety of factors that affect water restoration costs, according to the experts at St. Louis Cleaning & Restoration. It involves identifying the source of the water, removing the water, cleaning all contents affected by the water, removal of unsalvageable contents, drying the area, removing mold and bacteria if necessary, and finally reconstructing damaged structures. It can be a lengthy process but, with an experienced water damage restoration company, it is manageable."

These factors include the water's source (how difficult it is for the restoration team to identify, reach, and put an end to the unwanted water), the volume of water involved as well as the size of the area it affects (the more damage there is, the more work a crew will have to do to resolve the situation completely), how much time has elapsed since the leak began and the restoration team was called onsite, and so on. Those who suffer water damage to their property, or who are at risk for water damage, should also be aware that their insurance will play a role in the amount they pay out of pocket. St. Louis Cleaning & Restoration states, "Most standard homeowners or business insurance policies will cover water damage caused by any sudden and accidental event." They caution, however, that, "floods and water damage caused by other acts of nature typically are not covered."

It then follows that the overall cost of a water damage restoration project will depend on these contributing factors. In light of this, the company seeks to reassure homeowners and other parties that understanding the reason for these costs may help them mitigate problems in the future.
