The unit moves heat rather than converting it from a fuel source, allowing for incredible efficiency ratings."

Ductless systems have three main parts: an outdoor condensing unit; an indoor wall-mounted air handler; and a conduit that connects the outdoor unit to the indoor air handler through a small hole in the wall. Up to five indoor units can be connected to a single outdoor unit to allow zoned heating and cooling. When compared to standard systems, like a furnace or AC, there is actually no comparison. Ductless heat systems have the highest seasonal energy efficiency ratio (SEER) ratings in cooling, the most efficient electric heat

source available, and there is no energy loss resulting from leaky air ducts.
