



## **Insurance Covered Breast Pumps Reveals that Enfamil Formula Can Be Covered by Insurance**

Insurance Covered Breast Pumps, based in Bloomington, Illinois, has revealed that Enfamil formulas can be covered by health insurance. The company provides insurance covered breast pumps and supports mothers through the Affordable Care Act (ACA). ACA requires health insurance plans to cover breastfeeding support and supplies, which means that infant formulas like Enfamil and breast pumps can be covered by health insurance, especially the specialty formulas.

Enfamil has a number of specialty formulas. One is the Enfamil Premature Formula, which was developed specifically for low birth-weight infants. The Enfamil Premature Formula has been designed to contain high levels of nutrients that help in promoting growth. This particular infant formula is milk-based and contains high levels of vitamin D and protein. Also, it contains a blend of ARA and DHA, which are two nutrients found in breast milk.

Another specialty formula is the Enfamil Enspire Infant Formula. This is for newborns and infants up to 12 months of age. It has been developed to be as close to breast milk as much as possible. It contains lactoferrin, which is a primary protein found in breast milk and colostrum. This formula has also been

developed to help in brain-building, which is why it contains Omega-3 DHA and MFMG. It has also been ascertained to offer all of the nutritional requirements for babies up to 12 months of age.

A third specialty formula from Enfamil is the Enfamil EnfaCare, which has been designed primarily for premature infants. As such, this formula was created to support development and growth in babies that have been born before they reach full-term. EnfaCare is milk-based and contains 22 calories per fluid ounce. It has been found that babies who were fed Enfamil EnfaCare during their first year of life were able to attain catch-up growth to that of full term, breastfed infants.

Insurance Covered Breast Pumps also announced that Enfamil coupons and free formula samples that can be helpful for moms and their babies are also available. To receive these coupons, moms will need to join Enfamil Family Beginnings, after which they will receive their coupons through email. Furthermore in about a week or two, they will get a welcome box that will be delivered to their homes. This box will contain several coupons and an infant feeding guide.

Under ACA, breastfeeding service and supplies have to be covered by many health plans and have been required to implement the change with first plan/policy year that began on or after August 1, 2012. For people with a private health insurance plans or commercial insurer, ACA is also applicable to them. It should be noted that Insurance Covered Breast Pumps has established agreements with most commercial insurance companies for the coverage of certain infant formulas. They can help moms by collaborating with the insurance company of each customer for the filing of an insurance claim on behalf of the customers. There are many health insurance plans that can cover specialized formulas for infants and babies. Moms who want to receive these specialized formulas at no cost to them because insurance will be paying for them can visit the Insurance Covered Breast Pumps web page on how they can qualify through insurance for infant nutrition.

Moms who are interested will need to fill out an online form after which the company will contact the insurance firm, after which they will inform the customers about their infant formula coverage. The company will then request for a prescription from the customer's doctor and then submit the necessary documents to the insurance company. After the insurance company has approved it, they will then ship the formula directly to the customer's home, without any shipping charges.
