Ice dams occur when a ridge of ice forms at the end of the roof, thereby preventing the melting snow from draining as it should. This can cause a lot of damage to the walls, ceilings, insulation, floors, and other parts of the home. This commonly occurs during the winter months in almost all parts of the US, including Utah.

Ice damming is the process by which the ice dams are cleared from the edge of the roof. Ice dams often occur at the lowest edge of the roof and they are usually the result of the build up of heat that melts the snow on the roof. The melted snow then flows to the cold edge of the room to form an ice dam. There are many factors that contribute to the formation of an ice dam. These include insulation, solar orientation, snow cover, ventilation, the architecture of the home, tree coverage, weather conditions, and the lifestyle of the homeowners.

Daryl Olsen advises homeowners to be proactive in preventing an ice dam and to call a professional ice damming company if they notice that an ice dam has formed. It should be noted that it has nothing to do with the gutter system. However, it can damage the gutter system because ice is heavy. The gutters are not designed to carry such weight. This is one reason why calling for professional help as soon as possible when an ice dam occurs is essential.

It should also be noted that ice dams may not always be visible from the ground. While some may be visible as little glaciers on the gutter, some of the ice dams are located far out of sight. However, a professional ice damming company can easily determine if an ice dam is present. That is why ensuring that the ice damming company is well experienced is recommended. And ice dams don't have to be thick to cause substantial damage to the home. With a low-pitched roof, even a small ice dam can result into a lot of damage to the house in the long run.
