Because these amino acids are both hard to avoid and highly toxic if the body isn't processing them properly, people with maple syrup urine disease often need a special

diet of formula that is free of the amino acids their bodies cannot process. This is just one of the many conditions treated with specialty infant formulas and medical food powders now available from Insurance Covered Breast Pumps.

To place an order for specialty infant formula, customers fill out an order form that asks for information about the patient, the reason they need formula, as well as information about their insurance and doctor. With this information, Insurance Covered Breast Pumps contacts the doctor for a prescription and then bills the customer's insurance for the cost of the formula. Because the Affordable Care Act requires most health insurance plans to cover breast feeding support and supplies, many people with health insurance could be eligible to receive their infant formula, breast pump and other supplies at no cost. Insurance Covered Breast Pumps will even ship directly to the customer's home for free.
