According to Greiner Orthopedics, traditional methods of partial replacement work by placing cutting blocks (or guides), "on the thigh bone (femur) and shin bone (tibia) to help direct a surgical saw in removing the diseased bone and cartilage." This method has been considered technically challenging, as accurately placing these blocks with accuracy is a difficult and involved process.

Fortunately, a new, more accurate method exists that can address these issues and give more patients a higher chance of successful outcomes for their surgeries: the Navio System. Attendees will learn more about the NAVIO Robotics-assisted Surgical System, which is offered at Greiner Orthopedics for patients with severe osteoarthritis that causes serious pain and issues with movement. Utilizing this highly advanced approach to knee surgery, a skilled surgeon can work in conjunction with the Navio system to place a knee implant with incredible precision that takes each patient's unique anatomy into account. As such, patients will potentially experience benefits in improved function and tactile feedback. "Through an advanced computer program, the NAVIO system provides robotic assistance that relays precise information about your knee to a robotics-assisted handpiece used by our surgeons during the procedure," explains Greiner Orthopedics. "By collecting patient-specific data, boundaries are established for the

handpiece so we can remove the damaged surfaces of your knee, balance your joint and position the implant with greater precision. The system includes advanced instrumentation that is designed to supplement bone resurfacing with the surgeon-detailed plan as well as a robotics-assisted handpiece that can enable access through smaller incisions. Overall, computer assistance is provided that ensures both consistent and accurate results.

Led by Dr. Greiner, the team at Greiner Orthopedics takes a full-body approach to patient care. Dr. Greiner is a board-certified orthopedic surgeon (from the American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery) who earned his medical degree at the Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences College of Osteopathic Medicine. Along with knee replacement surgery, he specializes in the treatment of musculoskeletal, bone and joint issues, with a focus on sports injuries, joint replacement, arthritis management, and trauma and fracture management.
