Walla says that after that is done, they will then do any surface preparation to the cabinets and the doors that is necessary. He says they will also cover the areas in the kitchen near the cabinets and mask them off so no paint inadvertently gets on them.

Walla went on to say that many people are choosing to paint their kitchen cabinets these days as opposed to replacing them. He says that?s because of the tremendous amount of money people can save by doing this. The owner was also quick to add that his interior crews are so talented at painting kitchen cabinets that they come out looking practically brand new anyway.

He also noted that any type of winter interior painting work they do is getting more popular due to the fact that low VOC paints are now readily available. It used to be that people were reluctant to get interior painting in a home done in the winter because of the strong odor that petroleum-based solvents in the paint left behind. This bothered many customers because they could not ventilate their homes much during the colder months. Walla says low VOC paints are water-based so they give off very little odor once the painting is done.

One of the more unique interior painting services that the company offers is what they call ?rent a painter for the day?. The owner says it?s the perfect way for those that have many odds-and-ends interior painting jobs they do not want to do themselves to get that painting work done. He says this can be anything from painting a single room to painting all of the exterior doors in a home. The customer hires one of the company?s painters for a flat rate fee for the day and they choose what interior painting work they want to be done during that day.

Walla also likes to remind area residents that once the colder weather moves on and is replaced by warmer spring weather, Fishers painting contractors like them will start to see the demands for their services quickly peak.
