"Radon is a colorless, odorless radioactive gas that's produced by decaying uranium. It's present in nearly

all soils, and very low levels of radon are found in the air we breathe every day, according to the American Cancer Society," states the company through their article. They add, "The problem occurs when radon gas enters your home and gets trapped. Long-term exposure to high levels of radon can cause lung cancer. Radon testing is the only way to know whether your home has high levels of radon, which is the first step in addressing the issue and protecting yourself from this invisible threat."

Having outlined the risks of radon, Bell Harig Home Inspections advises homeowners all across the Marshall area to get their houses radon-tested, sharing some insight into how they can do this reliably and promptly. The blog's author states, "There are many ways you can get your house radon-tested, though we advise you not to skimp on expenses as this could lead to you being in the exact situation you are trying to avoid. The first thing to avoid, according to Bell Harig Home Inspections, is short term radon test kits. These kits have been proven to be an unreliable method of measuring exposure to radon gas, as studies have shown that these tests present imprecise recordings up to 99% of the time when compared to some of the other options. The difference in accuracy is significant enough to render these kits nearly obsolete, and only to be used as a last resource.

Long term radon test kits are a more reliable option, as these measure levels for 90 days up to one year. These are based on alpha particle tracking, which produces a more accurate indicator of average annual levels, which can vary significantly from day to day and month to month based on factors such as a drop in air pressure, gusty winds, variable soil moisture and snow cover (which traps radon gases).
