In cases like this, even something like a small fire on a stove can cause an entire floor of a building to be saturated with water.

When this happens, all that water will start ruining fabrics, woodwork and will also lead to rapid mold and mildew growth. This then will become a big project that only seasoned fire and water damage restoration companies like ours can handle.?

Finn went on to say that how they handle the fire and smoke restoration portion of the damaged structure depends on how big the fire was. He says that small fires that were quickly contained usually only result is smoke and soot damage that needs to be cleaned up. Larger fires will of course, require much more than that. They will start by helping the property owner salvage any of the contents in the home or building that were not impacted by the fire. This includes paperwork, supplies, inventory, computer systems, clothing, sentimental items and more. Finn says after that, they will clear out items that have been severely damage by the fire and prepare to haul them away. He went on to add once a building is ready for cleaning, they will leave no stone unturned getting that building back to normal by using advanced smoke and odor removal and deodorization techniques. They will even perform HVAC duct cleaning to NADCA standards.

As far as water damage restoration is concerned after any fire, Finn says this work is also meticulously performed by the company?s technicians using the latest and best equipment. That includes HEPA vacuums, air scrubbers, negative air fans, ozone machines, and state-of-the-art drying and moisture monitoring equipment. He says their equipment is designed to totally remove moisture and odors from such items as carpeting, drapes, and upholstery.
