The doctors at Denver Pain Management Clinic advise patients not to wait until the pain becomes severe before they take pain medication. This is because pain is easier to control when it is still mild, and pain

medication must be taken regularly, just as prescribed. Thus, the pain medication must be taken on a regular schedule, even when the patient does not feel pain.

And with regards to the possibility of the patient becoming addicted to narcotic pain medications. The likelihood of a person becoming addicted will depend on his or her addiction history. Addiction to the pain medication is less likely if a person has never abused drugs or had an addiction disorder. People will have to consult with their doctor regarding any worries that they may have.

It should also be noted that patients may develop a tolerance to a drug, which means that the patient will need to take more of their medicine to have the same effect after a certain period of time. Tolerance is a normal physiological response to narcotics and happens when the initial dosage loses its effectiveness over time. The solution is to modify the dose or medication. However, becoming more tolerant to a drug does not necessarily mean that the patient has become addicted to the drug.

They also want to explain that pain is a signal to let the person know when the body requires help. Their physicians will use a number of narcotic and non-narcotic analgesic medications to block pain, and offer comfort. Pain medication is vital because coping with chronic pain can result in anxiety, stress, and depression. If left untreated, pain issues can substantially affect the patient's personal relationships and even job performance.
